APPLICATION: Petition to classify status of alien relative for issuance of immigrant visa

The petitioner appeals from the May 1, 2008, decision of the California Service Center Director ("Director") denying the visa petition filed on behalf of the beneficiary. The record will be remanded for further proceedings.

The petitioner filed the visa petition on behalf of the beneficiary as the adopted child of a United States citizen. The Director concluded that the petitioner and the beneficiary had a prior relationship, and that the petitioner concealed material facts in response to the Director's December 5, 2007, request for additional evidence, namely whether the beneficiary's natural parents resided with the petitioner after the adoption and exercised primary parental control over the beneficiary. The petitioner argues that he complied with the requests for evidence and did not attempt to conceal any evidence.

We find that a remand is warranted in this case. The Director concluded that the beneficiary's natural parents "resided" with the petitioner and exercised primary parental control over the beneficiary because they visited the petitioner and the beneficiary. The record reveals that the beneficiary's natural father visited the petitioner and the beneficiary from July 29, 2004, until August 11, 2004. The record further reveals that the beneficiary's natural mother visited the petitioner and the beneficiary from May 30, 2005, until September 18, 2005. We do not regard these single visits, of 3 weeks and 3 months, respectively, as "residing" with the petitioner, nor is there evidence that the biological parents exercised primary parental control over the beneficiary during their visits. The petitioner is the beneficiary's natural uncle because the petitioner's wife and the beneficiary's biological mother are sisters. Accordingly, it is not unusual for siblings to visit each other, and given

the distance between South Korea and Texas, the lengths of the visits does not seem unreasonable or likely to challenge the petitioner's power to exercise primary parental control over the beneficiary. Furthermore, we find no attempt to conceal the visits of the biological parents by the petitioner when he responded to questions regarding the residence of the biological parents. The single international visit by each biological parent of a period of weeks cannot be construed as a change in residence. Accordingly, we find that the decision of the Director must be reversed. *See Matter of Tawfik*, 20 I&N Dec. 166 (BIA 1990) (Director's decision must be based on substantial and probative evidence).

ORDER: The record is remanded to the DHS for further proceedings and for the issuance of a new decision, consistent with this opinion.
