


Motion to Reopen/Reconsider: 2524

PETITION: Immigrant Petition for Alien Worker (Form I-140)

DISCUSSION: Reference is made to Immigrant Petition for Alien Worker (Form I-140) filed by

(the petitioner) on behalf of the Community of the Community of the Petitioner on I-140 was denied by U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) because the petitioner failed to submit requested evidence.

On April 03, 2009, the petitioner filed a Notice of Appeal (Form I-290B). Form I-290B was filed within the 30 day period (33 days if the denial was received by mail), but the appeal will be concluded in this office as a motion to reopen or reconsider in order for USCIS to take favorable action.

8 C.F.R. § 103.3(a)(2) states:

AAU appeals in other than special agricultural worker and legalization cases—(i) Filing appeal. The affected party shall file an appeal on Form I–290B. Except as otherwise provided in this chapter, the affected party must pay the fee required by §103.7 of this part. The affected party shall file the complete appeal including any supporting brief with the office where the unfavorable decision was made within 30 days after service of the decision.

- (ii) Reviewing official. The official who made the unfavorable decision being appealed shall review the appeal unless the affected party moves to a new jurisdiction. In that instance, the official who has jurisdiction over such a proceeding in that geographic location shall review it. (iii) Favorable action instead of forwarding appeal to AAU. The reviewing official shall decide
- whether or not favorable action is warranted. Within 45 days of receipt of the appeal, the reviewing official may treat the appeal as a motion to reopen or reconsider and take favorable action. However, that official is not precluded from reopening a proceeding or reconsidering a decision on his or her own motion under §103.5(a)(5)(i) of this part in order to make a new decision favorable to the affected party after 45 days of receipt of the appeal.

8 C.F.R. § 103.5(a)(8) states:

Treating an appeal as a motion. The official who denied an application or petition may treat the appeal from that decision as a motion for the purpose of granting the motion.

8 C.F.R. § 103.5(a)(2) states in pertinent part:

Requirements for motion to reopen. A motion to reopen must state the new facts to be provided in the reopened proceeding and be supported by affidavits or other documentary evidence...

8 C.F.R. § 103.5(a)(3) states:

Requirements for motion to reconsider. A motion to reconsider must state the reasons for reconsideration and be supported by any pertinent precedent decisions to establish that the decision was based on an incorrect application of law or Service policy. A motion to reconsider a decision on an application or petition must, when filed, also establish that the decision was incorrect based on the evidence of record at the time of the initial decision.

The evidence submitted overcomes the grounds stated for denial, because xxx.

CONCLUSION: It is concluded that the grounds stated for denial have been overcome.

ORDER: It is ordered that the petitioner's notice of appeal be concluded in this office as a motion to reopen or reconsider, and that the original decision denying Form I-140 be withdrawn. It is further ordered that Form I-140 be approved. Notice of the approval will be forwarded under separate cover.






