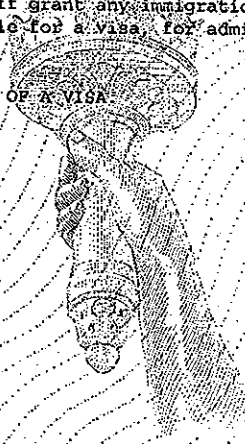



APPLICATION: Petition to classify status of alien relative for issuance of immigrant visa

The petitioner appeals from the May 1, 2008, decision of the California Service Center Director ("Director") denying the visa petition filed on behalf of the beneficiary. The record will be remanded for further proceedings.

The petitioner filed the visa petition on behalf of the beneficiary as the adopted child of a United States citizen. The Director concluded that the petitioner and the beneficiary had a prior relationship, and that the petitioner concealed material facts in response to the Director's December 5, 2007, request for additional evidence, namely whether the beneficiary's natural parents resided with the petitioner after the adoption and exercised primary parental control over the beneficiary. The petitioner argues that he complied with the requests for evidence and did not attempt to conceal any evidence.

We find that a remand is warranted in this case. The Director concluded that the beneficiary's natural parents "resided" with the petitioner and exercised primary parental control over the beneficiary because they visited the petitioner and the beneficiary. The record reveals that the beneficiary's natural father visited the petitioner and the beneficiary from July 29, 2004, until August 11, 2004. The record further reveals that the beneficiary's natural mother visited the petitioner and the beneficiary from May 30, 2005, until September 18, 2005. We do not regard these single visits, of 3 weeks and 3 months, respectively, as "residing" with the petitioner, nor is there evidence that the biological parents exercised primary parental control over the beneficiary during their visits. The petitioner is the beneficiary's natural uncle because the petitioner's wife and the beneficiary's biological mother are sisters. Accordingly, it is not unusual for siblings to visit each other, and given

the distance between South Korea and Texas, the lengths of the visits does not seem unreasonable or likely to challenge the petitioner's power to exercise primary parental control over the beneficiary. Furthermore, we find no attempt to conceal the visits of the biological parents by the petitioner when he responded to questions regarding the residence of the biological parents. The single international visit by each biological parent of a period of weeks cannot be construed as a change in residence. Accordingly, we find that the decision of the Director must be reversed. *See Matter of Tawfik*, 20 I&N Dec. 166 (BIA 1990) (Director's decision must be based on substantial and probative evidence).

ORDER: The record is remanded to the DHS for further proceedings and for the issuance of a new decision, consistent with this opinion.

PETITION: Immigrant Petition for Alien Worker (Form I-140)

DISCUSSION: Reference is made to Immigrant Petition for Alien Worker (Form I-140) filed by [REDACTED] (the petitioner) on behalf of [REDACTED]. On March 04, 2009, Form I-140 was denied by U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) because the petitioner failed to submit requested evidence.

On April 03, 2009, the petitioner filed a Notice of Appeal (Form I-290B). Form I-290B was filed within the 30 day period (33 days if the denial was received by mail), but the appeal will be concluded in this office as a motion to reopen or reconsider in order for USCIS to take favorable action.

8 C.F.R. § 103.3(a)(2) states:

AAU appeals in other than special agricultural worker and legalization cases —(i) Filing appeal.

The affected party shall file an appeal on Form I-290B. Except as otherwise provided in this chapter, the affected party must pay the fee required by §103.7 of this part. The affected party shall file the complete appeal including any supporting brief with the office where the unfavorable decision was made within 30 days after service of the decision.

(ii) *Reviewing official.* The official who made the unfavorable decision being appealed shall review the appeal unless the affected party moves to a new jurisdiction. In that instance, the official who has jurisdiction over such a proceeding in that geographic location shall review it.

(iii) *Favorable action instead of forwarding appeal to AAU.* The reviewing official shall decide whether or not favorable action is warranted. Within 45 days of receipt of the appeal, the reviewing official may treat the appeal as a motion to reopen or reconsider and take favorable action. However, that official is not precluded from reopening a proceeding or reconsidering a decision on his or her own motion under §103.5(a)(5)(i) of this part in order to make a new decision favorable to the affected party after 45 days of receipt of the appeal.

8 C.F.R. § 103.5(a)(8) states:

Treating an appeal as a motion. The official who denied an application or petition may treat the appeal from that decision as a motion for the purpose of granting the motion.

8 C.F.R. § 103.5(a)(2) states in pertinent part:

Requirements for motion to reopen. A motion to reopen must state the new facts to be provided in the reopened proceeding and be supported by affidavits or other documentary evidence...

8 C.F.R. § 103.5(a)(3) states:


Requirements for motion to reconsider. A motion to reconsider must state the reasons for reconsideration and be supported by any pertinent precedent decisions to establish that the decision was based on an incorrect application of law or Service policy. A motion to reconsider a decision on an application or petition must, when filed, also establish that the decision was incorrect based on the evidence of record at the time of the initial decision.

The evidence submitted overcomes the grounds stated for denial, because xxx.

CONCLUSION: It is concluded that the grounds stated for denial have been overcome.

ORDER: It is ordered that the petitioner's notice of appeal be concluded in this office as a motion to reopen or reconsider, and that the original decision denying Form I-140 be withdrawn. It is further ordered that Form I-140 be approved. Notice of the approval will be forwarded under separate cover.

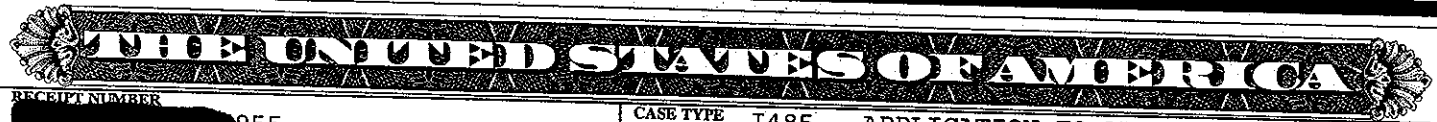
